19	Unique Circumstances, the City Commission may authorize non-competitive procurements if		
20	it finds unique circumstances to establish that competitive bidding is not in the best interest or		
21	the City; and

23	WHEREAS, an Agreement between the City of Hallandale Beach and Limousines of		
24	South Florida for Minibus Services (RFP # 2013-2014-002), began on June 1, 2014 and was		
25	in effect until September 2019; and		
26			
27	WHEREAS, on June 20, 2019, at the City Commission meeting it was adopted		
28	Resolution # 2019-46, authorizing a month to month agreement as needed for up to six months		
29	under provisions of the existing contract with Limousines of South Florida Inc.; and		
30			
31	WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, the City declared the state of emergency due to globa		
32	pandemic of COVID-19. The state of emergency affected all busines and economies, and		
33	resulted in the inability for the City and Limousines of South Florida, Inc., to reach ar		
34	agreement for the award of RFP FY 2018-2019-007, as solicited by the City and proposed b		
35	the Contractor; and		
36			
37	WHEREAS, in order to continue to provide free-fare shuttle bus service to the public		
38	without disruption, while the City pursues a new procurement process, the City and		
39	Limousines of South Florida, Inc., enter a six-month period from May1st 2020 to October 31		
40	2020 under the City Manager's Emergency Powers at an increased cost of \$ 51.94 to reflect		
41	the increased maintenance cost of the aging fleet; and

43	WHEREAS, the City has ordered five (5) new propane fueled, ADA compliant, vehicles		
44	pursuant to the ILA with Broward County that have been delayed due to production issues,		
45	but are expected in the Spring of 2021; and

47	WHEREAS, the City desires to continue p	roviding Community Shuttle services to the	
48	public without disruption and Contractor is able to continue providing services with the actual		
49	vehicle fleet under existing conditions until the end April 30, 2021.

59	Limousines Of South Florida, Inc. The City Manager is authorized to execute the proposed		
60	agreement and related documents to effectuate the project.
