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RESOLUTION NO. 2024-020

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING UTILIZATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL PURCHASING SYSTEM (TIPS) NO.211001, TO CONTRACT WITH CONTRACT PROVINCIAL SOUTH, INC., D/B/A PSI ROOFING TO REPLACE THE ROOFS ON THE CITY'S FLEET AND MECHANICAL BUILDINGS, FOR A TOTAL NOT TO **EXCEED AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-**NINE THOUSAND: AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-8(6), Bids and Contracts from other Entities, of the City of Hallandale Beach Code, the City Manager may procure supplies, materials, equipment, and services pursuant to competitive bids and formal contracts of other governmental units when the best interests of the City would be served, subject to the requirement that any purchase in excess of \$50,000 requires City Commission approval, and pursuant to Section 23-9 Cooperative Purchasing, the City Manager may procure, without following formal contract procedure, supplies, materials, equipment and services, which are cooperative purchases and may to join with other units of government in cooperative purchasing plans, when the best interests of the city would be served; and

WHEREAS, the City's Department of Public Works' 7,200 sq. ft. fleet building (where City vehicles are maintained) and 300 sq. ft. mechanical building (where standby generators are stored) roofs have exhausted their life expectancy, and require replacement; and

WHEREAS, Contract No.211001, Job Order Contracting, International Purchasing System (TIPS), Department of Texas Region 8 Education Service Center, requires a third-party RS Means line-item verification to ensure the prices quoted by its contractors are within the construction industry standard, and such verification process has been conducted and confirming that the projected costs for this project are below the average costs; and

WHEREAS, Provincial South, Inc., d/b/a/ PSI Roofing provided an estimate to replace the fleet building roof for One Hundred and Seven Thousand Dollars (\$107,000) and the mechanical building roof for Twenty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$22,000), for a total not to exceed amount of One Hundred and Twenty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$129,000), which price includes permit, disposal fees, and a 20-year warranty for the flat roof systems; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it in the public interest to authorize utilization of Contract No.211001, Job Order Contracting pursuant to the International Purchasing System (TIPS), Department of Texas Region 8 Education Service Center, to contract with Provincial South, Inc., d/b/a/ PSI Roofing to replace the roofs on the City's Fleet and Mechanical buildings, for a total not to exceed amount of One Hundred and Twenty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$129,000), and authorize the City Manager to execute all relating documents.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1. Whereas Clauses.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize utilization of Contract No.211001, Job Order Contracting pursuant to the International Purchasing System (TIPS), Department of Texas Region 8 Education Service Center, to contract with Provincial South, Inc., d/b/a PSI Roofing to replace the roofs on the City's Fleet and Mechanical buildings, for a total not to exceed amount of One Hundred and Twenty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$129,000), and authorize the City Manager to execute all relating documents.
