RESOLUTION 2016 - 10

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING
THE UPDATE TO THE UNIFIED SEA LEVEL RISE PROJECTION
OF SOUTHEAST FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Southeast Florida Regional Climate Change Compact (“the Compact”) Steering Committee first convened a Technical Ad Hoc Work Group to develop a unified sea level rise projection for the Southeast Florida region in 2010; and

WHEREAS, in September 2014, the Work Group was reconvened for the purpose of updating the Compact’s Sea Level Rise projection based on projections and scientific literature released since 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Work Group recommended review and update of the projection following the release of the Fifth Assessment Report by the United Nations Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (“IPCC”); and

WHEREAS, the 2015 update to the Regional Sea Level Rise Projection incorporates the IPCC curve as the lower boundary and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineer’s curve as the upper boundary, which are considered appropriate guidance for the majority of land use and infrastructure planning decisions and investments by the region; and

WHEREAS, based on these curves, sea level rise is projected to be six (6) to ten (10) inches by 2030 and fourteen (14) to twenty six (26) inches by 2060; and

WHEREAS, the near term planning horizons (through 2060) are critical to implementation of the Southeast Florida Regional Climate Change Action Plan and Broward’s Community-wide Climate Change Action Plan and efforts to optimize the remaining economic life of existing infrastructure while advancing adaptation strategies; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the residents and public should support the 2015 update to the United Regional Sea Level Rise Projection for

35 Southeast Florida as the basis for sea level rise adaptation planning in Hallandale Beach and
36 across Broward County.

38 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF**
39 **THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

41 **SECTION 1. Supporting the 2015 Update to the Unified Regional Sea Level Rise**
42 **Projection.** The Mayor and City Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach support the 2015
43 update to the Unified Regional Sea Level Rise Projection for Southeast Florida.

45 **SECTION 2. Directions to City Clerk.** The Mayor and City Commission direct the City
46 Clerk to cause a copy of this resolution to be forwarded to all appropriate parties.

48 **SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
49 passage and adoption.


