| 24 | WHEREAS, the condominium association engaged a firm to prepare construction |
| 25 | drawings for a new porte-cochère at a cost of Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000), for which |

| 28 | WHEREAS, given the nature of the accident, Staff recommends reimbursement of |
| 29 | Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000) to Meadowbook Towers Condominium B, thus bringing |
