SHORT TITLE:

THE POLICE & FIRE PENSION BOARD APPOINTMENT

STAFF SUMMARY:

Pursuant to Section 21-330 of the Code of Ordinances (Exhibit 1), the Board of Trustees consists of five (5) members: two (2) legal residents appointed by the City Commission, one (1) active police officer elected by the active police membership, one (1) active firefighter elected by the active firefighter membership, and a fifth Trustee selected by a majority vote of the other four Trustees. The Code further provides that the City Commission shall appoint the fifth Trustee selected by the other four Trustees as a ministerial duty.

The following membership changes have occurred on the Police & Fire Pension Board:

- May 29, 2026: Trustee Ricky Buoni resigned from the Pension Board. Chris Grieco has since been selected to serve in the applicable trustee position in accordance with the governing provisions of the retirement plan.

- August 8, 2026: The term of Allan Miller, the Board's fifth Trustee, will expire. At its meeting held on July 20, 2026, the remaining four Trustees selected David J. Frazier, Jr. (Exhibit 2), to serve as the fifth Trustee for the ensuing four-year term, which will run from August 8, 2026, through August 8, 2030.

In addition, during its organizational meeting held on May 18, 2026, the Board elected Caleb DeVore to serve as Chair and Radu Dodea to serve as Secretary.

Mr. Frazier brings extensive public pension governance experience, having previously served approximately twelve years on the Miami Beach Fire and Police Pension Board, including as Chair, Secretary, and Trustee. He also holds the Certified Public Pension Trustee (CPPT) designation and has substantial experience in pension administration and investment oversight.

Pursuant to Section 21-330 of the Code of Ordinances, the City Commission is required to ministerially appoint the individual selected by the remaining four Trustees. Accordingly, the Pension Board has selected David J. Frazier, Jr. to serve as the fifth Trustee for the term ending August 8, 2030.

PROPOSED ACTION:

Staff recommends that the City Commission approve the appointment of David J. Frazier, Jr. as the fifth Trustee of the Hallandale Beach Police & Fire Pension Board for the four-year term commencing August 8, 2026, and ending August 8, 2030.
