SHORT TITLE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDAL BEACH, FLORIDA, **AMENDING** CHAPTER 5 BEVERAGES; SECTION 5-6. - DISTANCES BETWEEN BUSINESSES AND FROM SCHOOLS, PLACES OF WORSHIP AND PUBLIC PARKS TO DELEGATE THE AUTHORITY TO ISSUE DISTANCE SEPARATION WAIVERS TO THE PLANNING BOARD; PROVIDING ZONING FOR CONFLICT; **PROVIDING** SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

The Department of Sustainable Development is proposing amendments to Section 5-6 of the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances to revise the Alcoholic Beverage waiver process related to required distance separations from schools, places of worship, and applicable businesses. The proposed ordinance delegates authority to the Planning and Zoning Board to review and grant such waivers. Staff is requesting City Commission approval of the ordinance.

Background:

Currently, all applications for alcoholic beverage waivers that do not qualify for administrative review must be presented to the City Commission for a public hearing. This requirement applies to waiver requests regarding distance separations from schools, places of worship, and applicable businesses.

Current Situation:

The proposed Ordinance amends Section 5-6 delegating the authority to approve alcoholic beverage distance separation waivers to the Planning and Zoning Board. This change is intended to streamline the waiver process and reduce the number of items requiring City Commission hearings, while ensuring that waiver requests continue to receive public review and consideration. The amendment also preserves the City Commission's authority to revoke waivers if adverse impacts arise after approval.

Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to Article V, Division I, Section 5.01 of the City of Hallandale Beach Charter, a City Ordinance is required to amend an existing Ordinance.

Business Impact Estimate

The proposed ordinance will have no direct economic impact on private, for-profit businesses within the City. It merely delegates the authority to approve waivers from the City Commission to the Planning and Zoning Board. The process for requesting a waiver continues to require a single public hearing, with no modifications to the applicable fees.

Cost Benefit:

The passage of this ordinance will have no fiscal impact on the City.
