Mario,

The estimated total cost for your requested election to be held on November 7, 2017, is approximately \$ 218, 000. This estimated amount is based on a fifteen percent turnout of the Hallandale Beach voter population which is 22, 316. The projected cost is \$150,000. In addition, the cost of holding over the voting equipment that is scheduled to be returned to the vendor is approximately \$68, 000. This equipment has already been prepped for return to the vendor and will now need to be refitted with the original software in order to conduct your election.

Please keep in mind that the cost of your election would total \$48, 500.00 if you choose to participate in the regularly scheduled March 13, 2018 municipal election.
