13	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach Procurement Code currently provides		
14	authority to City Manager to select the evaluation committee to review proposals received		
15	in response to a Request For Proposals (RFPs); and		
16			
17	WHEREAS, Section 218.391, Fla. Stats., Auditor Selection Procedures, requires		
18	the City Commission of a municipality to establish an auditor selection committee which,		
19	at a minimum, consists of at least three members to assist the governing body in selecting		
20	an auditor to conduct annual audits for the City; and		
21			
22	WHEREAS, other statutes may require procedures and processes not		
23	contemplated by the City Procurement Code; and		
24			
25	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission find that amending Chapter 23 to		
26	authorize waiver in the event of any conflict with state law to be in the public interest.		
27			
28	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE		
29	CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:		
30	SECTION 1. Amendment. Chapter 23, Sec. 23-8, Exception to bid requirements,		
31	of the City of Hallandale Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to add to Sec. 23-8(8)		
32	as follows:		

33	Sec. 23-8. – Exception to bid requirements

35	(8) To the extent the provisions of this Chapter conflict with procurement		
36	requirements of State Law, the provisions of this Chapter are waived, and the		
37	City shall abide by the requirement of State Law.		
38			
39	SECTION 2. Conflict. All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the		
40	City of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed		
41	to the extent of such conflict.		
42			
43	SECTION 3. Codification. It is the inten	tion of the Mayor and City Commission	
44	that the provisions of this ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances; to effect		
45	such intention the words "ordinance" or "section" may be changed to other appropriate		
46	words.		
47			
48	SECTION 4. Severability. Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by		
49	a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the		
50	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.		
51			
52	SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final approval.
