





POLICY AND CODE CHANGES

Current and upcoming changes to common Code Compliance practices.











Trash found on right-of-way.

- Verify that it is not the appropriate week for pickup at that location.
- Verify no pickup was already requested.

Issue citation.

- Use Property Appraiser website to provide owner information on citation
- Write appropriate code section on citation
- Check if a repeat violation and include additional fine if it is.
- Write fine amount on citation including repeat amount if appropriate.
- No accruing fine should be used.
- •Give 24 hours compliance time on the citation.

Post citation to the property

- Front page of citation should be posted by front door.
- If unable to reach front door, post visibly in alternate location.
- Use document protection when posting.

Spray trash with orange paint

•All pictures should be time & date stamped

Take required

•Take picture of:

pictures.

- Violation before paint
- Violation after paint
- •Full view of property from the street
- Notice posted to property
- Address characters whenever possible.






Case Follow Up:



Mail Citation



2.This address should match owner address written on citation.

Open new case

1.Attach pictures and copy of the citation to the case.

2.Enter the amount of the fine on the fees screen in the case.

1 Che

- 1.Check property the next day
- If trash was removed take picture showing violation complied and attach to case.
- 3.If trash is still there submit work order to Sanitation for pickup.

Property Check:

- 1.If violator has appealed the ticket in writing with 10 days
 - a.Schedule for next available hearing
 - b.Advise violator of time& place for appealhearing in writing
- 2.If no written appeal received within 10 days.
- a.If fine was paid notate in case and close case.
- b.If fine was not paid schedule for imposition within three months.
- If imposition is scheduled send written notice of hearing to property owner.

Hearing is scheduled:

- 1.Attend hearing for any appeal of imposition.
- 2.Present case information and evidence to Special Magistrate


