29	The commission shall provide for an independent annual audit of all city				
30	accounts and may provide for such more frequent audits as it deems				
31	necessary. Such audits shall be made by a certified public accountant or firm of				
32 33	such accountants who have no personal interest, direct or indirect, in the fiscal affairs of the city government or any of its officers. The commission shall select				
34	the auditor in accordance with the requirements of Florida law. may, without				
35	requiring competitive bids, designate such accountant or firm of accountants				
36	annually or for a period not exceeding two (2) years. If the state makes such an

57 58	of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other that the part declared to be invalid.
