31 32	vacancy exists . The city clerk shall give notice of meetings of the city commission, <u>prepare agendas, shall keep the journal of its proceedings</u> , shall				
33	authenticate by his or her signature on record in full the book kept for the				
34	purpose of recording ordinances and resolutions of the commission, shall be the				
35	custodian of the seal and of all official city records, and shall perform such duties				
36 37	as shall be required by <u>state law,</u> this Charter, <u>or</u> by city ordinance. <u>The city clerk</u> shall be chosen solely on the basis of executive and administrative qualifications,

52	SECTION 4. Advertisement. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to		
53	advertise the referendum election contemplated herein all in accordance with the Code of		
54	Ordinances and the State of Florida Election Code.		
55	SECTION 5. Conflict. All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City		
56	of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent		
57	of such conflict.		
58	SECTION 6. Severability. Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a court		
59	of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a		
60	whole, or any part thereof, other that the part declared to be invalid.		
61	SECTION 7. Effective Date. The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective		
62	immediately upon adoption. The amendment contemplated herein shall become effective, if		
63	approved, upon certification of the vote in accordance with Florida Law.
