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18	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach was awarded a FDOT grant in 2020 in
19	the amount of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000) to acquire nine
20	(9) electric buses and related equipment, including charging stations, which grant required
21	a 50% match for a total project cost of Five Million (\$5,000,000), which was approved by

the City Commission via Resolution No. 2020-036; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission subsequently approved the utilization of the
 same State of Georgia Contract for a total of Five Million, Eighty-Two Thousand, Eight
 Hundred and Thirty-Seven Dollars (\$5,082,837) to include charging equipment; and

WHEREAS, on April 20, 2022 it was advised that the State of Georgia Contract had
approved an increase in the bus prices to a base cost of Six Hundred Thirty Thousand
Dollars (\$630,000) per bus,; and

WHEREAS, the bus Vendor has offered to sell to City each bus for Five Hundred 29 and Ninety Five Thousand Dollars (\$595,000), instead of for the new price of Six Hundred 30 and Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$630,000), and Staff recommends acceptance of the offer 31 and recommends that the City Commission authorize acceptance of the supplemental 32 funding from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) in the total additional 33 amount of Nine Hundred Six Thousand, Eight Hundred and Twenty-Eight Dollars 34 (\$906,828) to cover the differential in all nine vehicles through an amendment to the 35 existing Public Transportation Grant Agreement for the purchase of electric buses, and to 36 37 authorize the City Manager to execute any and all related documents.

46	amendment to the existing Public Transportation Grant Agreement for the purchase of
47	electric buses, and to authorize the City Manager to execute any and all related
48	documents.
