14	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach is home to over four hundred		
15	condominium, cooperative and multi-family homeowner associations; and

17	WHEREAS, as condo buildings age and deteriorate, the need for costly structural		
18	and safety repairs arise. These unexpected fees in the form of special assessments can		
19	place significant financial strain on condo owners, particularly seniors and those on fixed		
20	incomes; and

22	WHEREAS, the bill will make it easier for condo owners to afford special		
23	assessments assigned by their HOAs or Condo Associations by expanding access to two		
24	loan programs guaranteed by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to		
25	help cover the cost of special assessments for structural and safety related repairs, keeping		
26	Florida families safe, healthy, and in their homes.; and

28	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY		
29	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

31	SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed		
32	as being true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.
