AND THE CITY OF NAPLES IN AN AMOUNT 7 NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE THOUSAND, 8 SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND FORTY-TWO 9 CENTS (\$285,628.42), INCLUDING CONTINGENCY; AND 10 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 11 12 13 WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-8 Exception to Bid 14 15 Requirements, (6) Bids and Contracts from Other entities, the City Manager is 16 authorized to utilize competitive solicitations for supplies, materials, equipment, and services through vendor agreements with other governmental units, when the 17 best interests of the City would be served subject to the requirement that any 18 purchase in excess of \$50,000 requires City Commission approval; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the City lime softening water treatment units (the "Units") 21 22 typically go through a rehabilitation once every ten (10) years, but it has been over 23 fifteen (15) years since this preventative Maintenance (PM) has been performed; 24 and 25 WHEREAS, rehabilitation of the Units will improve operating efficiency and will facilitate production of a finished water of high quality by 1) lowering operating 26 costs both in energy consumption and chemical consumption, 2) Providing savings 27 on sudden corrective maintenance expenses, and 3) Prolonging longevity of the 28 Units; and 29 30 WHEREAS, Southland Painting Corp., a coating contractor, proposes to 31 sand blast the entire internal surfaces of each treatment unit, strip and replace the 32 original coating with a new protective NSF^{\Delta} approved coating to protect the surface 33

of the unit from corrosion, and address any hidden damages that will be revealed by stripping; and

WHEREAS, Southland Painting Corp. has proposed to provide the above services for Two Hundred Thirty Eight Thousand, Twenty Three Dollars and Sixty-Eight Cents (\$238,023.68) and staff recommends a 20% contingency of Forty-Seven Thousand, Six Hundred Four Dollars and Seventy-Four Cents (\$47,604.74) to cover any price increases or unforeseen work, which in this case could be higher than the normal 10% due to the strong possibility of discovering hidden damage to the unit(s) after the sand blasting preparation process reveals the true surface condition for a total Not-to-Exceed amount of Two Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand, Six Hundred Twenty-Eight Dollars and Forty-Two Cents (\$285,628.42); and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission authorize procuring the services of Southland Painting, Corp. to paint the North and South treatment units, utilizing the City of Naples' BID # 19-051 – Sandblasting, Painting, Coating Services source agreement for a Not-to-Exceed amount of Two Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand, Six Hundred Twenty-Eight Dollars and Forty-Two Cents (\$285,628.42), including a 20% contingency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize utilization of the agreement between Southland Painting Corp. and the City of Naples for a Not-to-Exceed amount of Two Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand, Six Hundred Twenty-Eight Dollars and Forty-Two Cents (\$285,628.42), including a 20%
