A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AND RATIFYING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT RELATED TO OPIOID LITIGATION WITH WALGREENS; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

SUMMARY

The State of Florida has reached settlement with Walgreens in the opioid litigation. The proceeds of the settlements are intended to be allocated in accordance with the allocation as agreed to in the Florida Plan MOU, previously approved by this commission for allocation of the proceeds from the distributors and Johnson & Johnson settlement. In accordance with the MOU, the City is estimated to receive approximately \$144,103.

The amount of funds provided to the City will depend on the number of participating municipalities.
