21	amend an adopted budget when the amendment will change the expenditures and

23 24	WHEREAS, the FY 2021-2022 adopted budget did not reflect the revenue,	
25	expenditures, appropriations and other miscellaneous adjustments reflected herein; and	
26	WHEREAS, this proposed budget amendment is still within the allotted time	
27	pursuant to Florida Statutes; and	
28 29	WHEREAS, the City Administration proposes that the FY 2021-2022 adopted	
30	budget be amended to include the following transactions:

89 90	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and
91	incorporated herein.

93	SECTION 2. Adoption of Budget Amendment. The Mayor and City
94	Commission hereby adopt the budget amendment to the FY 2021-2022 adopted budget
95	as set forth in Attachments A of this ordinance.

97	<b>SECTION 3. Conflict.</b> All ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions, or parts
98	of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, to the extent of the conflict.
99 100	SECTION 4. Severability. Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared by
101	a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of
102	this Ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof, other than the part that is declared to be
103	invalid.

105	SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon
106	adoption.
