17 18	WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation is authorized to provide funding for
19	a mass transportation project; and
20	WHEREAS, the City submitted a Transit Service Development Grant Proposal to the
21	FDOT in June 2019 with the primary purpose of requesting financial assistance to fund nine (9)
22	electric buses, ten (10) charging stations, and supporting technology including on-board cameras
23	free internet WIFI, automated passenger counters, and an ADA sound and visual system to
24	announce stops; and
25	WHEREAS, on January 27, 2020, the City received a notification of grant award, advising
26	that the City had been awarded a grant, and that the proposed project had been entered into the
27	State Department's Work Program for appropriation in the current year budget; and
28	WHEREAS, the Public Transportation Grant Agreement for financial assistance wil
29	impose certain obligations upon the recipient, the City, and includes the provision by it of the loca
30	share of the project cost.
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32	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY \top HE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF
33	THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
