Re: <u>CORRECTED UPDATED -</u> Pricing Breakdown for Purchase of K7M – 30Ft Electric buses from the Georgia Statewide Contract 99999-001-SPD0000138-0008 – BYD Motors LLC

BYD Motors LLC is currently under contract with the State of Georgia to facilitate the purchase of electric buses as per **Georgia Statewide Contract 99999-001-SPD0000138-0008.** On March of 2022, due to the increase in vendor pricing and the PPI increase (from 1/1/21 to 12/31/21) of 7.48% and the increase of 15.33% from 1/1/22 to 3/1/22, as well as the special increase request to the K7M model in particular due to the bus base price being lower than the market price for this model.

The following was the justification provided to the State of Georgia, which resulted in the State approving the increase on all our models but in particulate our 30ft K7M model.

- 1. Modification to increase the price posted on the State of Georgia contract for the K7M.
 - a. K7M 197 kWh is discontinued, upgraded to K7M 215 kWh.
 - b. Price increase from \$504,474 to \$630,000. Reasons for the price adjustment include but not liminted the following:
 - i. Battery capacity upgrade.
 - ii. Vendor cost increase. BYD has been notified of price increase starting 2022 (increase range 5% 15%). Vendor letters can be provided upon request.

- iv. Logistic Cost Increase since pandemic started in early 2020

Because of the details provided above, and since we initially quoted Hallandale Beach at the end of November 2021, more than 90 days from the initial quote we are respectfully requesting and in good faith, Hallandale beach approve the proposed pricing increase as shown in the table below.

As already understood by the City and BYD, the purchase of nine K7M – 215kWh – 30FT model with DC chargers using the Georgia Statewide Contract 99999-001-SPD0000138-008 resulting from the eRFP number 99999-SPD-SPD0000138: Event Name: Public Mass Transit & Transportation Vehicles and Related Equipment and Accessories, as the procurement vehicle used to procure through a statewide cooperative contract.

The following pricing is for the City of Hallandale Beach based on the aforementioned contract and includes the base bus price plus the optional items as requested to be included on the proposed bus model. In addition, we would like to mention that the base bus price on the state contract for this model is \$630K, however; BYD is in good faith offering the city a lower unit price for the base bus of \$595K. The pricing provided below is valid for 90 days and can be subject to change unless we have a fully executed NTP, SPO and Contract.
