





## **AERIAL VIEW**



# **REQUEST**

**Nightclub License** pursuant to Section 5-9 of the City's Code of Ordinances in order to serve alcoholic beverages 7 days a week until 6 A.M. at the Amsterdam Restaurant.



## **BACKGROUND**

**September 2006** – License expired for Thira Taste of Greek, the previous Nightclub license at the property. (4 A.M. closing)

**November 21, 2021-** The Planning and Zoning Board recommended denial of Application # CL-21-3344 for a 6:00 AM Nightclub license for the Amsterdam Restaurant by a vote of 3 to 0.

**February 2, 2022 -** The City Commission denied Application # CL-21-3344 for a 6:00 AM Nightclub license for the Amsterdam Restaurant by a vote of 5 to 0.

**April 21, 2022 -** The applicant filed the subject application #CL-22-1814 for a 6:00 AM Nightclub license for the Amsterdam Restaurant.

May 25, 2022 – The Planning and Zoning Board recommended approval with conditions of Application #CL-22-1814 by a vote of 3 to 2.




View From SOUTH FEDERAL HIGHWAY

### APPLICABLE CODES AND ORDINANCES

- Alcoholic Beverage Establishments in the Central RAC Zoning District are permitted per standards in Chapter 5, Alcoholic Beverages.
  - Alcoholic beverage sales are not permitted after 2:00A.M. unless a Nightclub License for 4 A.M. or 6 A.M. is approved by the City Commission.
- Section 5-9 of the Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances permits Nightclub licenses (issuance and renewals) subject to conditions:
  - ➤ Planning & Zoning Board recommendation of approval or denial to the City Commission.
  - The City Commission may grant the license, deny the license, or grant the license subject to specific conditions.
  - The license may be revoked at any time if there are adverse effects resulting from the operation.



#### INTERDEPARTMENTAL REVIEW

- Building Division and Fire Department No objections to extended hours as will not change the occupancy or the maximum capacity of the business.
- Code Compliance Division Requested a hold on the application until active code issues are resolved:
  - Repairs and painting of the back perimeter wall and eradication of graffiti on the gates, electrical box and trash area.
- 3. **Police Department** Reported 37 service calls to the property from July 15, 2021, to May 3, 2022, with 3 calls of concern violent in nature.
  - At present, no objections to approval of the extended hours to 6:00 AM.



## REVIEW OF APPLICATION CRITERIA

#### **FINDINGS**:

The Application has been found inconsistent with the review criteria for nightclub licenses:

 Sufficient operational parking is not available onsite for patrons. A plan of action/ agreement in a form satisfactory to staff is required to address spill-over onto other properties.



## **RECOMMENDATIONS**

#### Staff recommended conditions of approval:

- 1. The Police Department detail officers' hours shall be extended to end at 6:30 A.M. at a staffing level as determined by the Police Department.
- 2. Additional measures shall be implemented to address parking overflow issues. Such measures (such as, providing lease agreements for additional off-site parking) must be reviewed and approved by Staff and the City Manager <u>before</u> the issuance of the Nightclub license.
- 3. Compliance with the code violations referenced in the memorandum from the Code Compliance Official *before* the issuance of the Nightclub license.
