19	city's governing board prior to final adoption.

29	Directors hereby adopt and establish the proposed millage rate for FY 2022-2023 at .6600
30	mills, which is \$.6600 per \$1,000.00 of assessed property within the Three Islands Safe
31	Neighborhood District.
