SHORT TITLE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE LEASE OF THE CITY OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT 300 SOUTH FEDERAL HIGHWAY, HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA TO BROWARD COUNTY FOR USE AS THE HALLANDALE BEACH BRANCH LIBRARY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

Second reading of an Ordinance of the City of Hallandale Beach, Florida approving and authorizing City Manager to execute a Contract with Broward County for the property located at 300 S. Federal Hwy for continued use as the Hallandale Beach Branch Library for an initial term of five (5) years, and five (5) additional optional terms of five (5) years, for a total potential lease term of thirty (30) years.

Section 5.01 (4)(f) of the City Charter and Section 20-17 of the City Code of Ordinances require that leasing of City land be authorized by Ordinance.

Background:

On August 10, 2022, the City Commission approved the Hallandale Beach Branch Library for an initial term of five (5) years, and five (5) additional optional terms of five (5) years, for a total potential lease term of thirty (30) years.

In 2009, the City Commission approved Ordinance 2009-11 authorizing the lease of the City owned property north of City Hall, to Broward County for Library purposes. The lease agreement (Exhibit 2) was for a 10-year term expiring on September 30, 2019. Since its expiration, the lease has continued on a month-to-month basis, per the terms of the agreement. The County currently pays a rent of one dollar (\$1) per year under the agreement.

Current Situation:

The proposed Ordinance was approved on First Reading with a 4-0 vote on August 10, 2022.

Why Action is Necessary:

Section 5.01 (4)(f) of the City Charter and Section 20-17 of the City Code of Ordinances require that leasing of City land be authorized by Ordinance.

Cost Benefit:

This lease agreement provides library services to the community at no additional cost to the City.

PROPOSED ACTION:

The City Commission consider the attached Ordinance on 2nd reading in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Hallandale Beach to provide the library services and grant authority for the lease of the space through the adoption of an Ordinance.
