**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING CITY TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE 2022 EDWARD BRYNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE SOLICITATION GRANT PROGRAM (JAG22) FOR FUNDING IN FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023; PROVIDING FOR ACCEPTANCE OF THE GRANT AWARD AND EXECUTION OF ALL DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**STAFF SUMMARY:**

**Summary:**

Staff seeks authorization to submit an application to the U.S. Department of Justice 2022 for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Solicitation Grant Program (JAG22) for funding in fiscal year 2022/2023.

**Background:**

The Justice 2022 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG22) offered by the U.S. Department of Justice, is a program that provides law enforcement agencies with resources to address a wide range of community and department needs.

Law enforcement agencies participating in the JAG22 receive funds pre-determined by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement. Although the fund allocations are non-competitive, cities must still apply to receive funding. The City of Hallandale Beach applies for JAG funds annually.

**Current Situation:**

Per the Program requirements, a public notice must be made for acceptance of the grant. Staff conducted one (1) advertised notice on the Police Departments website to gather information from the public. The program also requires all applications be approved by the City Commission.

If approved, JAG22 funding will become available during fiscal year 2022/2023 and utilized to purchase a vehicle hitched police smart message board for the Police Department. The police smart message board will assist to disseminate important information to the public.

**Why Action is Necessary:**

Pursuant to Article V, Section 5.01, of the City of Hallandale Beach Charter, Resolutions are to be presented to and adopted by a majority of the Commission. Furthermore, per Broward County and the JAG program guidelines, a resolution of the City Commission authorizing the grant application is required.

**Cost Benefit:**

The City leverages various funding sources to enhance services and projects through grant funding. The JAG22 grant will offset costs in the General Fund in the amount of \$16,590 to purchase a police smart message board.

**PROPOSED ACTION:**

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt the attached resolution authorizing the submittal of grant applications to the (FY2022-2023) U.S. Department of Justice 2022 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Solicitation Grant Program and the execution of any and all grant documents.
