10 11	WHEREAS the City of Hallandale Reach owns, appraise, and maintains a
	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach owns, operates, and maintains a
12	water and wastewater (sewer) utility, and has a long-established agreement with
13	the City of Hollywood to transmit the wastewater sewage at volume rates; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, the City's finance department engaged an outside consultant,
16	Raftelis Financial Consultant, Inc., to assist in performing a five-year utility rate
17	study covering fiscal years 2023 through 2027, which study is being completed in
18	two phases to avoid delays in the issuance of utility revenue bonds and the
19	completion of infrastructure projects; and

21	WHEREAS, during a September 12, 2022 City Commission workshop,
22	phase one of the FY 2023-2027 Utility Rate Study was presented by the outside
23	consultant and the proposed rate increases for water and wastewater were
24	discussed; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 30, Article I, Section 30-3(b), City of
27	Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, any rate, fee, or charge provided for in this
28	chapter shall be set as approved by the City Commission, and as part of the fiscal
29	year 2023 budget approval, staff is bringing this item to the City Commission for
30	adoption; and

32	WHEREAS, pursuant to the recommendations in the forthcoming Water,
33	Wastewater, and Stormwater Utility Rate Study, City Staff proposes a forty (40%)

percent increase to the water rates, a five and twenty-five hundredths (5.25%) percent increase to wastewater rates, and a ten (10%) percent increase to stormwater rates to take effect October 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, staff proposes that the Mayor and City Commission adopt the recommendations of Raftelis Financial Consultant, Inc.'s forthcoming Water, Wastewater, and Stormwater Utility Rate Study to set and amend the City's Water and Wastewater rates approving a forty (40%) percent increase to the water rates, a five and twenty-five hundredths (5.25%) percent increase to wastewater rates, and a ten (10%) percent increase to stormwater rates to take effect October 1, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part hereof.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission adopt the recommendations of Raftelis Financial Consultant, Inc.'s Water, Wastewater, and Stormwater Utility Rate Study to approve a forty (40%) percent increase to the water rates, a five and twenty-five hundredths (5.25%) percent increase to wastewater rates, and a ten (10%) percent increase to stormwater rates to take effect October 1, 2022.

SECTION 3. The "Schedule of Fees and Charges" dated October 1, 2022, which is on file with the City Clerk, shall be amended in accordance with the recommendations, and adopted as the schedule of fees and charges applicable in the City of Hallandale Beach for water and waste water charges and services rendered by the City, on or after October 1, 2022:

SECTION 4. The City Manager is authorized to promulgate and publish such fees and charges and shall insure the proper collection and accounting of all monies arising therefrom. In the event of doubt or ambiguity, the City Manager is authorized to determine the appropriate fee.

SECTION 5. Conflict. All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 6. Severability. Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other that the part declared to be invalid.

SECTION 7. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
