4 5 6 7 8 9	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF A FERAL BEEHIVE AT 622 SW 9 ST PURSUANT TO ORDER OF THE CODE ENFORCEMENT SPECIAL MAGISTRATE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
11	WHEREAS, City Code Section 14-4(b)(2) holds property owners responsible for
12	the extermination of any rodents, vermin and other pests. City Code sections 14-11(1)
13	and 14-11(3) holds property owners responsible for removing any public hazards; and
14	WILEDEAS purpuent to Florido Statuto Section 162.06(4) the Code Enforcement
15	WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida Statute Section 162.06(4), the Code Enforcement
16	department may set matter for an expedited hearing if it is a serious threat to the public
17	health, safety and welfare, and the local governing body is authorized to make all
18	reasonable repairs which are required to bring the property into compliance and to charge
19	the violator with the reasonable costs of the repairs in addition to the fine; and
20	WILEDEAS on everying has calculated at COO SW O Street in the year young
21	WHEREAS, an oversized bee colony exists at 622 SW 9 Street, in the rear yard,
22	adjacent to Sunrise Park. While bees are an important agricultural resource, Florida
23	Administrative Code Rule 5E-14.151 classifies feral bees as a pest that can be removed.
24	The location of the feral hive in proximity to a public park is of particular concern as it is a
25	danger to members of the public that may use the park and may be allergic to bee stings, a potentially fatal situation; and
26	a potentially fatal Situation, and
27 28	WHEREAS, the Special Magistrate issued an order which found that the situation
29	did constitute a threat to public health, safety and welfare and authorizes the City to
30	proceed with removal of the hive.
31	proceed with removal of the flive.
32	WHEREAS, the City has obtained an estimate of removal costs of approximately
33	\$895, although total costs will not be known until the hive can be examined. The bee
34	removal specialists will attempt to save and relocate the bees to a managed colony if
35	possible.

41	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and
42	incorporated herein.

44	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City to proceed
45	to take the necessary actions to abate the public hazard presented by the oversized bee
46	colony at 622 SW 9 Street, in accordance with the Order of the Special Magistrate and as
47	permitted by Florida Statute, and to seek an order imposing the actual costs of repair and
48	fines on the property owner.

50	SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
51	its passage and adoption.
