SHORT TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GOLDEN ISLES SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, SUBMITTING THE DRAFT SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD DISTRICT PLAN AMENDMENT TO THE CITY COMMISSION FOR A DETERMINATION OF CONSISTENCY WITH THE CITY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

Per Section 163.516 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.), the Golden Isles Safe Neighborhood District (GISND) is required to develop a Safe Neighborhood Improvement Plan (SNIP) which serves to meet the requirements and intent of the City of Hallandale Beach Ordinance No. 88-10 and the Safe Neighborhoods Act of Florida. Subsection 163.516(4) requires that the SNIP is consistent with the City's Comprehensive Plan. It is essential for the plan to be prepared in compliance with these rules and guidelines in order for the district to maintain its status.

Background:

GISND was established by City Ordinance in August 1988. In 1989, the City of Hallandale Beach District Board of Directors approved through resolution the creation of an Advisory Board, comprised of property owners or residents of the district. The Advisory Board reviews in an advisory capacity, in public session, with City representatives on the following items:

- Safe Neighborhood Improvement Plan,
- District Budget and Improvements,
- District Bylaws; and
- Related matters, as necessary for consideration and approval of the Board of Directors.

The purpose of the SNIP Update is to assess existing conditions within the district and provide a framework and funding necessary for the continuation of GISND vision, goals and objectives. The assessment contains the analysis of current data relevant to the district, including demographics, crime, land use, zoning and transportation.

The goal of the Safe Neighborhood District is to provide a safe and secure environment for residents of GISND through community policing, environmental design and environmental security.

Current Situation:

The GISND Advisory Board reviewed the draft SNIP update and provided a favorable recommendation to the GISND Board of Directors at the June 29th meeting. The Advisory Board Meeting Minutes are provided in Exhibit 2.

Why Action is Necessary:

Per Section 163.516 of the F.S., the district is required to update its SNIP; which serves to meet the requirements and intent of City Ordinance No. 88-10, and the Safe Neighborhoods Act of Florida. Subsection 163.516(4) F.S. requires this document to be consistent with the City of Hallandale Beach Comprehensive Plan. It is essential that the plan update is prepared in compliance with these rules and guidelines in order for GISND to maintain its status.

Before the GISND Board of Directors can review and approve the SNIP, it must first forward the SNIP to the City Commission to confirm the Plan's consistency to the City's Comprehensive Plan.

PROPOSED ACTION:


Staff recommends the GISND Board of Directors review the proposed SNIP and forward the plan to the City Commission which will confirm its consistency.

After the SNIP is confirmed to be consistent by the City Commission, the Plan will be provided to the GISND Board of Directors to review and approval at a future Board meeting.
