SHORT TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF NINE (9) VEHICLES APPROVED UTILIZING THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT AND THE SOURCEWELL (NJPA) CONTRACTS FOR A TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY-ONE DOLLARS (\$479,841); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

The purpose of the agenda item is to request City Commission approval of the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to purchase the vehicles listed below utilizing the Florida Sheriff's Association (FSA) FSA 20.0- EQU18.0 FSA 21 in an amount not to exceed \$345,461; and the Sourcewell (NJPA) Contract # 2022.5 091521-NAF and 060920-NAF contracts in an amount not to exceed \$134,380, for a total not to exceed amount of \$479,841.

Background

As previously communicated to the City Commission, staff is in the process of conducting a comprehensive review of the Fleet Maintenance and Replacement Program during FY2021-22 to better determine Citywide replacement needs and replacement schedule, along with a sound financial plan for the next five years. In the meantime, immediate needs must be addressed for operational capacity and efficiency related to Utilities. The budget for these replacements were not accounted for in the FY2021-22 budget due to uncertainties with funding availability. Therefore, on December 15, 2021, the City Commission approved Ordinance no. 2021-025 (Exhibit 2) amending the FY 2021-2022 budget to purchase six (6) replacement vehicles/equipment, units 723,714, 973, 858, 968 and 993 (See table on page 3).

On March 2, 2022, the City Commission approved Ordinance No. 2022-004 (Exhibit 3) amending the FY 2021-2022 budget. This budget amendment authorized the following new positions which require adding four (4) vehicles to the City's fleet (See table on page 3).

Current Situation:

Following is a list of the ten (10) vehicles that were approved in the two (2) FY 2021-2022 budget amendments. However, one of the vehicles is not available until 2023 due to supply-chain issues. Therefore, nine (9) vehicles are being purchased in FY 2021-2022.
