22	physical facilities; and

24	WHEREAS, this trust fund provides property insurance for all City facilities which currently						
25	totals \$107,177,754. There is a \$25,000 deductible per incident except for windstorm damage						
26	which is 5% per value of the building deductible; and

28	WHEREAS, the property insurance for all City facilities provided by this trust fund						
29	represents the cost to replace damaged property with property of like kind and quality; and						
30 31	WHEREAS, the City Administration is recommending that the City renew its current						
32	property insurance with Florida Municipal Trust Fund for the total sum of Eight Hundred Ninet						
33	Five Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Six (\$895,486) Dollars for fiscal year 2022-2023; and

35	WHEREAS, the City believes it is in the best interest of the City to renew the City's current						
36	property insurance through the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund.
