20	amend an adopted budget when the amendment will change the expenditures and
21	revenues; and
22 23	WHEREAS, the FY 2021-2022 adopted budget did not reflect the revenue,
24	expenditures, appropriations and other miscellaneous adjustments reflected herein; and
25	WHEREAS, this proposed budget amendment is still within the allotted time
26	pursuant to Florida Statutes; and
27 28	WHEREAS, the City Administration proposes that the FY 2021-2022 adopted
29	budget be amended to include the following transactions:
30 31 32 33	<ol> <li>Transfer from the General Fund to the Transportation Fund – \$411,754. These expenditures will be funded by General Fund reserves;</li> </ol>

37 38 39	<ol> <li>Transfer from Utility Impact Fee Fund to the Utility Fund – \$379,884. This expenditure will be funded by Utility Fund reserves;</li> </ol>
40 41	<ol> <li>Transfer from the Trust Fund to the Tree Trust Fund – \$58,220. This expenditure will be funded by General Trust Fund reserves;</li> <li>ORD. NO. 2022 -</li> </ol>

64	as set forth in Attachments A of this ordinance.
65 66	SECTION 3. Conflict. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions, or parts
67	of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, to the extent of the conflict.
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69	<b>SECTION 4. Severability.</b> Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared by
70	a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of
71	this Ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof, other than the part that is declared to be
72	invalid.
