THE FUTURE LAND 6 USE ELEMENT OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH 7 8 ADOPTED COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; PROVIDING FOR AN 9 INCREASE TO THE NUMBER OF REGIONAL ACTIVITY CENTER (RAC) RESIDENTIAL UNITS IN THE REGIONAL 10 11 ACTIVITY CENTER LAND USE PURSUANT TO POLICY 2.4.1 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY LAND USE PLAN. 12 **PROVIDING FOR** TRANSMITTAL OF 13 THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TEXT AMENDMENT PURSUANT 14 TO CHAPTER 163, FLORIDA STATUTES, PART II, 15 ("COMMUNITY PLANNING ACT"); PROVIDING FOR 16 CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND 17 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 18 19 WHEREAS, a total of 464.49 net acres (637.6 gross acres) were designated as 20 Regional Activity Center (RAC) Future Land Use on July 21, 2010, by the City 21 Commission with the adoption of Ordinance #2010-11 and Ordinance #2010-12; and 22 WHEREAS, the RAC land use designation is intended for downtown and 23 redevelopment areas, regional employment center, centers for tourism, and areas 24 surrounding regional community facilities; and 25 WHEREAS, the Hallandale Beach Comprehensive Plan calls for the City to direct 26 27 development and redevelopment in its central core to areas adjacent to major transportation corridors within the RAC; and 28 29 WHEREAS, pursuant to Broward County Land Use Plan Policy 2.4.1, residential densities and hotel rooms within areas designated "Activity Center" on the Broward 30 County Land Use Plan, may be increased by twenty percent (20%) or five hundred (500) 31

dwelling units subject to certain criteria; and

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WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach has requested a text amendment to the 33 Regional Activity Center (RAC) land use designation within the Future Land Use Element 34 of the Comprehensive Plan to increase residential density; and 35 WHEREAS, the City has nearly exhausted all of the allotted 4,241 residential units 36 permitted since the adoption of the RAC; and 37 38 WHEREAS, the City is able to request five hundred (500) additional residential units within the RAC through a local Land Use Plan amendment and recertification 39 process through the Broward County Planning Council; and 40 41 WHEREAS, in order to continue with residential and mixed-use development with the Regional Activity Center, the City of Hallandale Beach is requesting five hundred (500) 42 additional residential units; and 43 WHEREAS, on, June 30, 2021, the Planning and Zoning Board serving as the 44 Local Planning Agency considered the Comprehensive Plan amendment to the Future 45 Land Use Element at a duly noticed public hearing; and 46 47 WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have conducted duly noticed public hearings on the proposed amendments to the City's Comprehensive Plan, as required by 48 Chapter 163, Florida Statutes; and 49 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2021-18 was previously adopted on October 6, 2021, 50 51 but was adopted prior to required unrelated amendments to the Comprehensive Plan and 52 therefore, was rejected during state review and must be repealed and replaced. 53 WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the proposed 54 amendments are in the best interest of the City of Hallandale Beach and its residents and hereby adopt this ordinance, 55 56 57

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## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

- **SECTION 1.** Ordinance No. 2021-18, previously adopted on October 6, 2021, is hereby repealed and replaced with the present ordinance.
- SECTION 2. Approval of Future Land Use Element. The Mayor and City Commission of Hallandale Beach, Florida hereby approve the Hallandale Beach Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use Element amendment as incorporated herein as attached "Exhibit 1A" to include the addition of five hundred (500) residential dwelling units, consistent with Chapter 163, Part II, Florida Statutes.
- **SECTION 3.** Transmittal. The Comprehensive Plan as hereby amended shall be transmitted to all appropriate reviewing agencies, including the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity, as provided in Section 163.3184, Florida Statutes.
- SECTION 4. Transmittal to the Broward County Planning Council. The Plan as hereby amended shall be transmitted for recertification to the Broward County Planning Council and shall be effective upon recertification by the Broward County Planning Council as provided in Chapter 163, Florida Statutes.
- **SECTION 5. Conflict.** All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- **SECTION 6. Severability.** Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other that the part declared to be invalid.
- **SECTION 7. Effective Date.** The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective concurrent to adoption of the City's Comprehensive Plan text amendment, pursuant to Section 163.3184, Florida Statutes.
