14	WHEREAS, Florida Statute Section 715.07 (2)(a)(1.a.) provides that any towed or			
15	removed vehicle or vessel must be stored at a site within a 10 mile radius of the point of removal			
16	in any county of 500,000 population or more; and			
17	WHEREAS, a review of the City's towing code section 28-7 (b)(1) has revealed			
18	inconsistency with Florida Statute 715.07 in that city code section 28-7 (b)(1) provides that any			
19	towed or removed vehicles must be stored at a site within five miles of the point of tow; and			
20	WHEREAS, the population of Broward County is greater than 500,000 and as such city			
21	code section 28-7(b)(1) must be amended to conform to Florida Law; and			
22	WHEREAS, the City Administration has examined Chapter 28 section 28-7 (b)(1) and is			
23	recommending that section 28-7 (b)(1) be amended to expand towing mile distance in			
24	accordance with Florida Law; and			
25	WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Commission have determined that it is in the best			
26	interest of the residents of the City of Hallandale Beach to amend Chapter 28 Section 28-7(b)(1)			
27	as recommended.			
28	NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF

That site must be open for the redemption of vehicles seven days per week, from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., and must have a person physically in the office to handle telephone calls Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., however may be closed to observe any legal holiday observed by the City of Hallandale Beach. When closed, the site shall have prominently posted a sign indicating a name and telephone number within the county where the operator of the site can be reached at all times. Upon receipt of a telephoned request to open the site to redeem a vehicle, the operator has one hour to return to the site or be in violation of this section. That line shall be kept open for receipt of these calls at all times; and if that line is busy for five continuous minutes, it shall create a rebuttable presumption that the line has been disconnected in violation of this section.

53	SECTION 3. Conflict. All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of		
54	Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent		
55	of such conflict.

57	SECTION 4. Codification. It is the intention of the Mayor and City Commission that the		
58	provisions of this ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances; to effect such intention		
59 60	the words "ordinance" or "section" may be changed to other appropriate words.		
61	SECTION 5. Severability. Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a court		
62	of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a		
63	whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

65	SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon
