The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and 102 incorporated herein. 103 104 SECTION 2. Adoption of Budget Amendment. The Mayor and City 105 Commission hereby adopt the budget amendment to the FY 2022-2023 adopted budget 106 as set forth in Attachments A of this ordinance. 107 108 SECTION 3. Conflict. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions, or parts 109 of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, to the extent of the conflict. 110 111 **SECTION 4. Severability.** Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared by 112 a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of 113 this Ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof, other than the part that is declared to be 114 invalid. 115 116 SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon 117 adoption. 118 119 PASSED AND ADOPTED on 1st reading, on January 18, 2023. 120 121 PASSED AND ADOPTED on 2nd reading, on February 1, 2023.
