Biden, Jr. declared an 15 emergency in the State of Florida and ordered Federal assistance to supplement state, tribal, 16 17 and local response efforts due to the emergency conditions resulting from Hurricane Ian beginning on September 23, 2022, and continuing; and 18 19 WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Grants Administrative Policy, a resolution of the 20 21 City Commission must authorize the approval and acceptance of grant applications and/or 22 awards over \$50,000; and 23 WHEREAS, City departments performed Hurricane Ian emergency protective 24 25 measures, including but not limited to placing barricades, emergency pumping, keeping pedestrians away from the beach, flood fighting, and security, resulting in an increase of labor 26 27 of approximately 918 overtime hours, approximately Sixty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$63,000), which may be reimbursed under the Grant; and 28 29 30 WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission approve and 31 accept the federally funded DR-4673-Hurricane Ian Subrecipient Agreement awarded through the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Federal Emergency Management 32 33 Agency (FEMA) to respond to and recover from Hurricane Ian, a major disaster/emergency and for limited mitigation measures, and authorize the City Manager to execute all relating 34 35 documents.
