20	can accommodate higher salinity raw water; and

23	wellfield, the City of Hallandale Beach will install one reverse osmosis (RO) skid within the existing		
24	membrane treatment facility, capable of treating potential increasing saline raw water, thus		
25	providing additional flexibility and redundancy in our drinking water operations; and

27	WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-4, Competitive Bidding Required, all		
28	purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated
