2	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF
4	THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING
5	THE SUBMISSION OF TWO (2) GRANT APPLICATIONS UNDER
6 7	THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS FOR THE 41st YEAR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)
8	FUNDING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016; AUTHORIZING THE
9 10	CITY MANGER TO EXECUTE AND IMPLEMENT FUNDING
11	AGREEMENT DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
12	
13 14	WHEREAS, the City applies for funds through the Community Development Block Grant
15	Program (CDBG) annually. The allocation is automatic and non-competitive, provided the
16	allocation is for HUD/CDBG eligible activities (which may include capital, economic development,
17	and housing and public service projects). Although the allocation is automatic, cities must apply
18	to receive funding; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, the City is desirous of submitting applications for the City of Hallandale
21	Beach's Public Works Improvements in the NW Quadrant (drainage, sewer lines, water lines,
22	sidewalks, regrading and sodding of swales and other related infrastructure improvements) and
23	The Friends of the Hepburn Center After School Tutorial Program Project; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, the City recognizes this as an opportunity to identify capital, economic
26	development, housing and public service projects for disadvantaged areas within the City; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, pursuant to the CDBG Program's requirements, on November 13, 2014, City
29	administration conducted an advertised public meeting to receive public comment regarding
30	proposed City projects, as well as projects the community would like to see implemented
31	Additionally, the City Administration scheduled a second advertised meeting for November 19
32	2014, at the Regular Meeting of the City Commission, where residents are invited to attend and
33	provide comments; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, in the 40th year, the Hepburn Center After School Tutorial Program was
36	awarded one hundred thousand (\$100,000) and the Public Works Improvements Project was
37	awarded one hundred eight thousand two hundred (\$108,200) dollars for a total of two hundred
38	eight thousand two hundred (\$208,200) dollars; and

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40	WHEREAS, although Hallandale Beach's 41st Year CDBG allocation has not yet been
41	released by HUD, Broward County Housing and Community Development Division advised the
42	City to utilize last year's application amounts as a guideline for completing the 41st Year CDBG
43	applications (Fiscal Year 2015-2016); and
44	
45	WHEREAS, should the allocation of funds be less or more than the requested amount,
46	the scope of work for both projects will be adjusted accordingly; and
47	
48	WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to apply for funding under the 41st Year
49	(Fiscal Year 2015-2016) Community Development Block Grant Program.

51 52 53	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
54	SECTION 1. City Commission Action. The Mayor and City Commission hereby
55	authorize the submission of two (2) grant applications: the City of Hallandale Beach's Public
56	Works Improvements in the NW Quadrant (drainage, sewer lines, water lines, sidewalks,
57	regrading and sodding of swales and other related infrastructure improvements) and The Friends
58	of the Hepburn Center's After School Tutorial Project under the 41st Year, (Fiscal Year 2015-
59	2016) Community Development Block Grant Program on behalf of the City.

61	SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute
62	and implement all necessary funding agreement documents.
63 64	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
65	passage and adoption.
