1 EXHIBT 1 2 **RESOLUTION NO. 2016 –** 3 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF 4 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING 5 6 THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND THE NECESSARY FUNDS, 7 BASED ON THE ESTIMATION OF EXPENSES PREVIOUSLY PROVIDED BY COUNSEL, TO COMPLETE THE EVALUATION 8 AND ASSESSMENT OF THE HIBISCUS ROAD PROJECT 9 INCLUSIVE OF THE RECOMMENDED DESIGN OF A POTENTIAL 10 RIGHT OF WAY IMPROVEMENTS, VALUATION ANALYSIS OF 11 THE LAND NECESSARY FOR PROPOSED RIGHT OF WAY 12 IMPROVEMENTS, INCLUDING 13 POTENTIAL **SEVERANCE** DAMAGES AND AUTHORIZING OUTSIDE COUNSEL TO 14 RETAIN THE NECESSARY INDUSTRY CONSULTANTS AND 15 UTILIZE SUCH OTHER INTERNAL MEASURES NECESSARY 16 FOR THE PROVIDING AN ANALYSIS AND OPINION ON 17 POTENTIAL BUSINESS DAMAGES; AND PROVIDING AN 18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** 19 20 WHEREAS, the City Administration has previously been authorized to explore the 21 22 construction of a roadway at the current incomplete Hibiscus Road site; and 23 WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have been provided an estimate of the future 24 costs to complete the proposed design alternative(s) for the proposed extension and infrastructure 25 improvements to Hibiscus Street right of way, analysis and valuation of the land necessary for the 26 27 right of way infrastructure improvements, including assessment of potential severance damages 28 to remainder property; and 29 30 WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach has entered into an agreement pertaining to the 31 non-admissibility of certain documents created and/or facts discovered through the voluntary 32 exchange of documents between the City and certain owners the Gulfstream Race Track land located to the immediate south of the site of the proposed Hibiscus Street right of way 33 infrastructure improvements; and 34 35 WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission desire to proceed with the due diligence 36 project to the extent of determining the recommended design alternative(s) of the proposed right 37

of way infrastructure improvements, the valuation of such the land as may be necessary to

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complete	the	proposed	Hibiscus	Street	right	of	way	infrastructure	improvements,	including
severance damages; and										

WHEREAS, it is imperative that certain other industry consultants be retained and other internal measures are necessary to provide an analysis and opinion on any potential business damages; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that, in order to engage in informed negotiations with the property owner(s), it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to expend the necessary funds to determine the recommended design alternative(s) of the proposed right of way infrastructure improvements, the valuation of such the land as may be necessary to complete the proposed Hibiscus Street right of way infrastructure improvements, including severance damages and to obtain an analysis and opinion on any potential business damages.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

 SECTION 1. City Manager's Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to expend the necessary funds, based on the estimation of expenses previously provided by counsel, to determine the recommended design alternative(s) of the proposed right of way infrastructure improvements, the valuation of such the land as may be necessary to complete the proposed Hibiscus Street right of way infrastructure improvements, including severance damages, and authorizing the City Manager to retain, through the outside counsel, the necessary industry consultants and utilize the necessary internal measures to provide an analysis and opinion on potential business damages.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
