8 9	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach began the implementation of a Community
	Benefit Program (CBP) in 2011; and

12	WHEREAS, on May 15, 2013, the City codified the Community Benefit Program unde
L3	Section 23-3 of the City's Code of Ordinance by setting forth the definition of a Community Benefi
L4	Plan; and

L 6	WHERAS, as required under the ordinance, the policy implementing the Community
L7	Benefit Program ("CBP") has been adopted within the Procurement Departments Standard
L8	Operating Procedure ("SOP"); and
L9	
20	WHEREAS, the threshold established requires the inclusion of a CBP for all Capita
21	Improvement Projects over \$1 Million. CBPs are encouraged for all non-Capital Projects, as well
22	as Capital Improvements Projects less than \$1 Million; and
23	
24	WHEREAS, the City Administration has been monitoring the implementation of the
25	Community Benefit Plan and its impact over the past few projects; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, on January 25, 2016, the City Administration provided the Hallandale Beach
28	Community Agency Board (HBCRA) with a history and update of the CBP; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, based on implementation and observations, the City Administration
31	recommends several changes to the administration of the program; and
32 33	WHEREAS, the City Administration is recommending changes to the following features o
34	the program: 1) the definition of local vendor will include tiered percentage dollar value calculation

35	2) contractual language requirements for contractors and subcontractors 3) definition of workforce
36	and 4) the definition of CBP calculation; and
37	
38	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission believe that changes suggested by the City
39	Administration is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Hallandale Beach.
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41	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
42	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
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44	SECTION 1. <u>Definitions</u>
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46	(a) Local Workforce Local Workforce shall be defined as any worker that is directly working
47	on the project, either during construction or in operations after construction, who resides
48	within the City as a renter or homesteaded property owner. Those classified as local
49	workforce shall be provided with not only work directly on the project, but also provided
50	the opportunity to generate a tangible sustainable impact after the project is complete.
51	This may include, but not be limited to, participation in an apprentice program, mentorship
52	program, training, long term employments beyond the term of the project, etc.
53	
54	(b) CBP Calculation. The calculation of the CBP commitment shall be the overall percentage
55	(%) of the contractual cost or otherwise defined in the agreement. The contractor's CBP
56	commitment in the contract includes local vendor/subcontractor utilization and local
57	workforce utilization. The overall percentage (%) calculation would be the total financial
58	sum of the above components.

60	SECTION 2. Tiered Local Vendor Commitment for a Community Benefit Plan to
61 62	include tiered percentage dollar value calculation.
62	(a) The intent of the Level Vandor tiered eveters is to provide a greater bonefit to Tier 1
63	(a) The intent of the Local Vendor tiered system is to provide a greater benefit to Tier 1
64 65	vendors (those individuals who both live and work in the city, followed by those
65 66	businesses who are located in the City, followed by individuals who reside in the City). Therefore, the following tiered percentage calculation will be utilized in calculating the
66 67	Therefore, the following tiered percentage calculation will be utilized in calculating the CBP commitment for vendor utilization:
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69	Tier 1: 100% dollar value
70	Tier 2: 75% dollar value
71	Tier 3: 50% dollar value
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73	SECTION 3. Contractual Language Requirement for Contractor and all
74	subcontractors.
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76	(a) Contracts which meet the threshold of projects of \$1 Million or more, shall require the
77	General Contractor, Developer, and/or Construction Manager to include the following,
78	same or similar language, in the bidding process and subsequent agreement to retain
79	subcontractors for the project:
80	
81	[Insert Contractor name] requires that all subcontractors commit to
82	supporting the City of Hallandale Beach Community Benefit
83	Program. Subcontractors will be required to commit TBD% of their
84	total contract value to hiring local Hallandale Beach vendors and
85	residents. A list of local vendors and residents that your firm intends
86	to hire MUST be submitted with your company's bid documents by
87	completing Exhibit XX.
88	
89	The following information MUST be included in Exhibit XX and
90	submitted with the bid package:
91	
92	 Local Vendors: company name, address, phone,
93	contact, copy of business tax license, scope of
94	work and value.
95	 Local Residents: resident name, address, phone,
96	copy of driver's license, scope of work, pay rate,
97	projected hours assigned to project.
98	 Acknowledgment: an authorized company official
99	must sign and have notarized Exhibit XX to

acknowledge that you understand and commit to

101	the requirements of the described Community
102	Benefit Plan.

104	SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
