

Scope of Services



A. <u>Predesign and site planning services</u>

- Multiple meetings with the stakeholder for Golden isles community
- Meetings with City Staff to review and define specific programmatic requirements of the project.
- Develop project program outlining goals and objectives for the final design
- Presentation of renderings and other design graphics
- Review and comply with land development regulations
- Formulate construction approach to include: Architecture, Civil Engineering, Mechanical, Plumbing and Electrical Engineers, Structural Engineers

B. Preparation of Permit and Construction Documents

• Proceed with the preparation of permit and construction documents the Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR) to obtain bids from qualified sub-contractors and to obtain necessary permits for construction.

C. Construction Administration Services

- Monitor the construction activities by the CMAR during the projected (12) month construction period.
- Site visits to observe the work for general compliance with the design intent
- Review the work and prepare a punch-list for the CMAR to complete







ACAI'S GOLDEN ISLES PARK COMMUNITY BENEFIT PLAN: YOUTH,

SPORTS AND RECREATION



Our **GICBP** will focus on the main elements of the Community Benefit Plan philosophy:1. Workforce utilization; and 2. COHB vendor utilization

The following initiatives summarize our Community Benefit Plan for Golden Isles Park as a plan that focuses on workforce utilization and COHB vendor utilization. Our GICBP represents a pledge in the range of 19% to less than 5% of the total project work.

- Local participation:
 - Hallandale Creative Printing will be contracted to provide printing needs for the project \$2,000 budget, total amount to be determined.
 - ACAI will schedule its COHB resident staff for involvement in the project -- \$20,000 budget.
 - Craven Thompson & Associates has committed to continue its COHB resident internship program \$15,000 budget.
- ACAI will continue its student mentoring and outreach program with STEM students at Hallandale Magnet HS during the design phase \$2,850 budget.
- ACAI will establish a scholarship as a post secondary educational initiative for the benefit of the Hallandale Magnet High School COHB resident graduating students *total amount not to exceed \$1,000*
- **CTA** will contribute to a scholarship fund for a COHB resident –*total amount not to exceed \$1,000*
