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c. The City Commission authorizes a loan from the Utility Fund to the Transportation Fund.

64 SECTION 4. That when the City of Hallandale Beach receives monies from any source, be 65 it private or governmental, by grant, gift, or otherwise, to which there is attached as a condition of 66 acceptance, any limitation regarding the use or expenditure of the monies received, the funds so 67 received need not be shown in the Annual Budget nor shall said budget be subject to amendment 68 or expenditure as a result of the receipt of said monies, but said monies shall only be disbursed 69 and applied toward the purposes for which the said funds were received. To ensure the integrity of 70 the Operating Budget, and the integrity of the monies received by the City under grants or gifts, all 71 monies received as contemplated above must, upon receipt, be segregated and accounted for based upon generally accepted accounting principles and placed into separate revenue and 72 73 expenditure accounts established to properly account for all such funds and expenditures. Any 74 money drawn from the established expenditure accounts may only be disbursed and applied within 75 the limitations placed upon the gift or grant.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances and all resolutions or parts of resolutions
in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 6. Should any section or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder hereof other than the part declared to be invalid.
