19	WHEREAS, Pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-8 (6), Bids and Contracts from othe
20	Entities, and Section 23-9, Cooperative Purchasing, the City Manager has the authority to
21	procure, without following formal contract procedure, all supplies, material, equipment and
22	services which are part of cooperative purchases plans, and has the authority to join other units
23	of government in cooperative purchasing plans, or to purchase pursuant to formal writter
24	contracts or competitive bids of other governmental units, when the best interests of the City
25	would be served, subject to the requirement that any purchase ex excess of \$50,000 requires
26	City Commission approval; and
27	WHEREAS, the City pursues opportunities to provide cost savings and cost avoidances
28	by partnering with the Broward Sheriff's office (hereinafter "BSO") logistics warehouse to procure
29	a variety of items for the Fire Department; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, emergency medical and fire equipment items purchased from BSO include
32	communications equipment, absorbents, basic and specialized tools, foam, personal protection
33	equipment, intravenous (IV) fluids, batteries, medical equipment, and over one hundred (100)
34	additional items; and
35	
36	WHEREAS, this cooperative procurement saves the City roughly twenty (20%) percen
37	on the purchase of supplies; and
38	

WHEREAS, the estimated costs of goods procured from BSO logistics for the Fire			
Department in FY 2017 is one hundred three thousand seven hundred fifty (\$103,750.00) dollars,			
and the Police Department is estimated to spend six thousand (\$6,000.00) dollars for FY 2017 for			
basic medical supplies for a total of one hundred nine thousand seven hundred fifty			
(\$109,750.00); and			

WHEREAS, the day to day supplies of the Fire Department are continuous and Fire Department staff can reasonably estimate, based on historical data and current budgets, that expenditures with BSO logistics for FY17 will exceed the City Manager's spending authority; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration requests authorization to procure the necessary equipment and supplies from the Broward Sheriff's Office logistics warehouse for the Fire and Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends that the Mayor and City Commission authorize the City Manager procure the personal protective equipment and supplies for the Fire and Police Department in the total amount of one hundred nine thousand seven hundred fifty (\$109,750.00) dollars as approved during the 2016-2017 fiscal year budgetary process as it is in the best interest of the City of Hallandale Beach and its residents.

 WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission recognize that the purchases from BSO are routine and necessary purchases for the continued operation of the Fire Department, and that it is in the best interest of the City of Hallandale Beach to be able to obtain the necessary equipment on a continuance basis; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to expend the funds to procure equipment and supplies from the Broward Sheriff's Office Logistics warehouse for the Fire and Police Department in the total amount of one hundred nine thousand seven hundred fifty (\$109,750.00) dollars as provided for in the fiscal year 2016-2017 budget as it is in the best interest of the City of Hallandale Beach and its residents.
