9	WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-8 (6) Bids and Contracts from Othe
20	Entities, and Section 23-9 Cooperative Purchasing, the City Manager has the authority to procure
21	without following formal contract procedure, all supplies, material, equipment and services which
22	are part of cooperative purchases plans, and has the authority to join other units of governmen
23	in cooperative purchasing plans, or to purchase pursuant to formal written contracts or competitive
24	bids of other governmental units, when the best interests of the City would be served, subject to
25	the requirement that any purchase in excess of \$50,000 requires City Commission approval; and

27	WHEREAS, the City receives fire rescue ambulance billing and related professiona
28	services under a cooperative agreement between the City of Lauderhill and Advanced Data
29	Processing, Inc. (ADPI); and

31	WHEREAS, the term of the agreement is from April 1, 2013 through April, 2016, with two
32	(2) one (1) year extensions available thereafter, until March, 2017. In April, 2016, the City of
33	Lauderhill exercised the first available one (1) year extension; and
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35	WHEREAS, the City is billed monthly on ADPI's ability to collect, and pays ADPI at a rate
36	of seven and one half (7.5%) percent of net collections; and
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39	WHEREAS, the payment rate is inclusive of collection performance, and electronic patient
40	care reporting (ePCR) computing services; and
41	
42	WHEREAS, based on historical data which the Fire Department maintains for revenue
43	and expenditures, staff is confident spending on ambulance billing and related services will
44	exceed \$50,000.00 into the future; and
45	
46	WHEREAS, since this expenditure is a contractual obligation that will recur annually, the
47	City Administration recommends authorizing the expenditure for billing services from ADPI for the
48	agreed percentage of collections amount for the life of the current agreement; and

50	WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends that the Mayor and City Commission
51	authorize the City Manager to expend the FY2016-2017 budgeted amount for the continued
52	services with Advanced Data Processing, Inc. (ADPI) under the negotiated rate of seven and one
