Staff Summary:

Background:

For Fiscal Year 2016-2017 the City of Hallandale Beach will be participating in the US Communities Contract # 11019 with The Home Depot for the purchase of supplies and materials.

The Procurement Department manages the subject contract, while each Department procures separately for maintenance, repairs and operations supplies, industrial equipment and tools.

The City's Expenditure Trends with this vendor for the last two (2) years are as follows: Fiscal Year 13-14 - \$81,719.53 Fiscal Year 14-15 - \$79,071.06 Fiscal Year 15-16 - \$80,934.42 through 9-21-16
