8	AND DESIGN DISTRICT; APPROVING THE AGREEMENT WITH
9	THE ARTIST FOR MURAL PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE
10	EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT WITH
11	THE ARTIST FOR MURAL PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE
12	ISSUANCE OF PURCHASE ORDERS FOR THE MATERIALS
13	AND RENTAL EQUIPMENT THE ARTIST WILL NEED TO
14	EXECUTE THE MURAL PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
15	EXCEED \$170,000; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 **WHEREAS,** an integral part of the mission of the Hallandale Beach Community 17 redevelopment Agency ("HBCRA") is the alleviation of slum and blight within the HBCRA 18 Community Redevelopment Areats; and

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WHEREAS, on November 24, 2015 the HBCRA submitted a grant application to the Community Foundation of Broward for the Art of Community: The Engagement Challenge 2016 (Grant No. 20150433) and on February 26, 2016 the Community Foundation of Broward informed the HBCRA staff that the HBCRA was one the selected recipients of this award; and

- WHEREAS, the award amount is \$75,000 and will be utilized for the revival of the Fashion Row Art and Design District, which will create a new identity for the area through increased visibility utilizing a vibrant component of colorful murals; and
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WHEREAS, in April 2016, pursuant to Resolution 2016-14, the HBCRA Board of Directors, approved the Grant Agreement between the HBCRA and the Community Foundation of Broward officially starting the process for the mural project; and

WHEREAS, On August 23, 2016, through a Call to Artist process, the HBCRA invited qualified artists to submit a proposal to design and execute the unified-themed mural and a Mural Artist Selection Evaluation Committee ("Evaluation Committee") comprised of the affected property owners was created to evaluate the proposals; and

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WHEREAS, on September 16, 2016, Jonathan Brender and Joshua Tiktin presented their proposals to the Evaluation Committee and, after the oral presentations and review of the proposals submitted, a majority of the members of the Evaluation Committee selected Jonathan Brender as the artist to design and implement the mural project; and

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44 **WHEREAS,** the Board of Directors of the HBCRA desires to ratify the Evaluation 45 Committee's selection of the artist, Johnathan Brender, for the mural project; approve the 46 Agreement between the artist and the CRA for the mural project; and authorize the issuance of purchase orders for the materials and rental equipment the artist will need to execute the muralproject in an amount not to exceed \$170,000.

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50 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF 51 DIRECTORS OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY:

52 Section 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The recitals in the whereas clauses are true and correct, and 53 incorporated into this Resolution.

54 Section 2. <u>Ratification of Selection of Artist by Evaluation Committee</u>. The selection of 55 by the Evaluation Committee of Jonathan Brender as the artist to design and implement the 56 mural project is hereby ratified.

57 Section 3. <u>Approval of Agreement with Artist</u>. The Agreement with the artist as attached 58 hereto as Exhibit "A" is hereby approved with such non-material changes as approved by the 59 HBCRA Executive Director and approved as to legal form and sufficiency by the HBCRA 60 Attorney.

61 Section 4. <u>Execution of Agreement with Artist</u>. The HBCRA Executive Director is 62 hereby authorized to execute the Agreement with the artist.

63 Section 5. <u>Implementation of Agreement with Artist</u>. The HBCRA Executive Director is 64 hereby authorized to take all steps necessary and appropriate to implement the terms and 65 conditions of the Agreement with the artist.

66 Section 6. <u>Issuance of Purchase Orders</u>. The issuance of purchase orders for the 67 materials and rental equipment that the artist will need to execute the mural project in an 68 amount not to exceed \$170,000 is hereby authorized.

69 Section 7. <u>Effective Date</u>. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
