Short Title:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE APPLICATION FOR AND EXECUTION OF THE FLORIDA RECREATION DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM GRANT AGREEMENT FOR THE RENOVATION TO BLUESTEN PARK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$281,500; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROVIDE FOR THE 50% MATCHING FUND; TO EXECUTE AGREEMENT AND RELATED DOCUMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Staff Summary:

Background:

The Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program (FRDAP) is a state competitive program which provides grants to local governmental entities for acquisition and development of land for public outdoor recreation projects that provide recreational enhancements and opportunities for individuals with unique abilities. Eligible participants include all county governments, municipalities in Florida and other legally constituted local government entities, with the responsibility for providing outdoor recreational sites and facilties for the general public.

This grant application pursues funds to assist with the redevelopment of Bluesten Park, inclusive playground and bankshot basketball court. The grant application was due to the State by August 17, 2016. Staff submitted the application amd isnow requetsings ratification and authorization for the City manager to execute related documents.

Each application is reviewed to determine eligibility. The Florida Office of Information and Recreation Services evaluates each eligible application according to Florida Administrative Code and assigns a final score. Based on the scores, DEP prepares and submits a recommended priority list to the Florida Legislature for funding consideration. Projects will be awarded December 31, 2016.

The amount of the grant, if awarded, is \$281,500, with a 50% match required from the City, for a total of \$563,000. The estimated Project Cost for these two elements is \$563,000. If awarded, the matching grant funds are available to the City in the Bluesten Park General Obligation Bond funding. Awardees are given three years to complete the projects.

Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to Article V, Section 5.01, of the City of Hallandale Beach Charter, Resolutions are to be presented to and adopted by a majority of the City Commission. Grant agreements require Commission approval prior to City Manager execution. . The Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program requires a 50% local match per grant application to obtain 50% grant funding.

Fiscal Impact:

The 50% matching funds of \$281,500 would come from the Parks General Obligation Fund Bluesten Park Project, Project PA151.

Proposed Action:

Staff recommends approval of the attached resolution ratifying_an application for and execution of the Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program Grant for the renovation to Bluesten Park in the Amount of \$281,500; Authorizing the City Manager to Provide for the 50% Matching Fund; and to Execute Agreement and Related Document.
