5 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF
6 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AWARDED
7 RFP #FY2015-2016-019, STORMWATER PIPE CLEANING TO
8 THE SECOND LOWEST RESPONSIVE, RESPONSIBLE,
9 BIDDER ENVIROWASTE SERVICE GROUP FOR AN AMOUNT
10 NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY EIGHT THREE
11 HUNDRED TWENTY SEVEN (\$578,327.00) DOLLARS;
12 AUTHORIZING A TEN PERCENT (10%) CONTINGENCY FOR
13 UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES; AND AUTHORIZING THE
14 CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND
15 TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT AND ALL RELATED
16 DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE PROJECT WITH
17 ENVIROWASTE LLC; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

20 WHEREAS, pursuant to City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 23, Section 23-6 – Award of
21 Contract, the City Manager shall have the authority to recommend to the City Commission award
22 of contracts; and
23

24 WHEREAS, the City, like other cities, has an underground network of stormwater pipes
25 that convey rain water to different lakes, canals, retention/detention ponds, and drains throughout
26 the City; and
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28 WHEREAS, the system is designed to move rain water from our streets in order to prevent
29 flooding, which can cause property damage, pose a health risk to residents and cause personal
30 injury; and
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32 WHEREAS, to ensure that the system works as intended, it is critical that it is inspected,
33 cleaned, and maintained on a routine basis; and
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35 WHEREAS, in May, of 2016, A.D.A. Engineering, Inc. was contracted in order to generate
36 stormwater pipe cleaning specifications, which would then be used to guide the firm that would
37 eventually be contracted to perform the actual pipe cleaning; and

39 **WHEREAS**, on July 11, 2016, the City released the Invitation to Bid #FY2015-2016-019,
40 Stormwater Pipe Cleaning. On July 20, 2016, a mandatory pre-bid conference took place, and
41 twelve (12) prospective bidders attended; and

43 **WHEREAS**, on August 18, 2016, five (5) bids were submitted by the deadline for receipt
44 of responses; and
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46 **WHEREAS**, the Evaluation Committee reviewed the submissions. Although Hinterland
47 Group, Inc. submitted the lowest bid, and Envirowaste Service Group provided the second lowest,
48 responsive, responsible bidder bid, staff is recommending the award of RFP #FY2015-2016-019,
49 Stormwater Pipe Cleaning to Envirowaste Service Group, because they hold an existing contract
50 with a municipality in which they perform the exact scope of services, and Hinterland Group, Inc.
51 submittal did not match the scope of services that the city is seeking; and

53 **WHEREAS**, the City Administration recommends that the City Commission award RFP
54 FY #2015-2016-019, Stormwater Pipe Cleaning to Envirowaste Service Group for an amount not
55 to exceed five hundred seventy eight thousand three hundred twenty seven (\$578,327.00) dollars;
56 and recommend a ten percent (10%) contingency for unforeseen circumstances. The City
57 Administration further recommends authorization for the City Manager and City Attorney to
58 negotiate and execute an agreement with Envirowaste Service Group; and

60 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City
61 Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.
62

63 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF**
64 **THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**
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66 **SECTION 1. City Commission Action.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby award
67 RFP FY #2015-2016-019, Stormwater Pipe Cleaning to the second lowest, responsive,
68 responsible bidder, Envirowaste Service Group.
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70 **SECTION 2. City Manager and City Attorney Authorization.** The Mayor and City
71 Commission hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an
72 agreement with Envirowaste Service Group for an amount not to exceed five hundred seventy

73 eight thousand three hundred twenty seven (\$578,327.00) dollars, and recommends a ten percent
74 (10%) contingency for unforeseen circumstances. The City Manager is further authorized to
75 execute all related documents to effectuate this project.
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77 **SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
78 passage and adoption.
