19 20	WHEREAS, the Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program (FRDAP) is
20	a state competitive program which provides grants to local governmental entities for
22	acquisition and development of land for public outdoor recreation projects that provide
22	recreational enhancements and opportunities; and
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25	WHEREAS, eligible participants include all county governments, municipalities in
26	Florida and other legally constituted local government entities, with the responsibility for
27	providing outdoor recreational sites and facilities for the general public; and
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29	WHEREAS, the FRDAP grant application offers funding that will assist with the
30	City's redevelopment of Bluesten Park which will include the playground and a bankshot
31	basketball court; and
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33	WHEREAS, in order to meet the grant application deadline, the City submitted a
34	grant application on August 17, 2016, which was the deadline for submission; and
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36	WHEREAS, each grant application will be reviewed to determine eligibility. From
37	there, the Florida Office of Information and Recreation Services evaluates each eligible
38	application according to the Florida Administrative Code and assigns a final score. Based

39 on the scores, DEP prepares and submits a recommended priority list to the Florida 40 Legislature for funding consideration. Projects will be awarded December 31, 2016; and 41

42 WHEREAS, the amount of the grant, if awarded to the City, will be \$281,500 dollars 43 with a 50% match being required from the City in the amount of \$281, 500 dollars, bringing 44 the total to \$563,000 dollars; and

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WHEREAS, the estimated Project Costs for these two (2) elements is \$563,000 47 dollars; and

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49 WHEREAS, if awarded the City's match of grant funding is available in the 50 Bluesten General Obligation Bond funding. Awardees are given three (3) years to 51 complete the projects; and

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53 WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends that the Mayor and City 54 Commission ratify the submission of grant application to the Florida Recreation 55 Development Assistance Program submitted on August 17, 2016, for funding to assist in 56 the redevelopment of Bluesten Park to include the playground and a bankshot basketball 57 court; authorize a City match of grant funds in the amount not to exceed \$281,500 dollars; 58 and authorize the City Manager to execute grant agreement and all related documents.
