10	Lobbyist Services. The City Commission awarded the Request for Proposal (RFP) to Ronald L.

20	WHEREAS, the initial contract period set forth in the RFP was one (1) year term,
21	commencing upon award by the City Commission, with four (4) additional one-year renewal terms,
22	which are contingent upon satisfactory performance of the services and available funding. At this
23	time, all renewal terms have expired; and
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25	WHEREAS, the City would not have its interests adequately represented during the 2017
26	Legislative Session without lobbyist services; and
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28	WHEREAS, City Administration seeks City Commission approval to engage Ronald L.
29	Book, P.A. for an additional one year term for the 2017 Legislative Session; and
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31	WHEREAS, immediately following the 2017 State Legislative Session, staff will release
32	and Request for Proposal for State Lobbyist Services to commence the 2017-2018 Fiscal year,
33	for a one (1) year term, commencing upon award by the City Commission, with four (4) additional
34	one-year renewal terms; and
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36	WHEREAS, pursuant to section 23-8(5), under unique circumstances, the City
37	Commission may find that competitive bidding is not in the best interest of the city. Section 23-

38	8(2) professional services, requires commission approval for professional services valued in
39	excess of twenty five thousand (\$25,000) dollars; and
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41	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City
42	Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.
