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27	WHEREAS, the City hired a Green Initiatives Coordinator in order to bolster its
28	sustainability efforts; and
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30	WHEREAS, currently, the City primarily focuses its efforts upon water conservation, but
31	the City Administration recommends that the program scope be expanded in order to achieve
32	internal and external sustainability; and
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34	WHEREAS, in order to achieve internal sustainability, efforts within the City must include
35	all departments if the City desires to reduce its environmental impact and prepare for a resilient
36	future; and
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38	WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends hiring a highly qualified, experienced
39	firm to develop a cohesive, logical, impactful and cost-effective five (5) year Sustainability Action
40	Plan that will lay the framework for the future of sustainability in the City; and
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46	WHEREAS, on September 6, 2016, the City released the Request for Proposal (RFP)
47	#FY2015-2016-024, Development of a Sustainability Action Plan; and
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49	WHEREAS, the RFP notice was sent to two hundred eighty four (284) vendors from the
50	City's vendor list, and was advertised in the Hallandale Beach Chamber of Commerce website,
51	as well as the Miami Minority Business Development Agency Business Center, the U.S. Small
52	Business Administration, and the Broward County Community Relations and Outreach Section
53	Office of Economic and Small Business Development; and
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55	WHEREAS, on September 14, 2016, a mandatory pre-proposal meeting took place. Four
56	(4) prospective bidders attended the meeting; and
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58	WHEREAS, the deadline for responses from proposers was October 14, 2016. Two (2)
