20	WHEREAS, pursuant to Fla. Stat. § 287.055 Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act			
21	(CCNA), an agency, including a municipality, must competitively select and negotiate with the			
22	most qualified firm for professional architectural, engineering, landscape architectural, land			
23	surveying services, and for projects where the basic costs of construction is estimated by the			
24	agency to exceed three hundred twenty five thousand (\$325,000.00) dollars. Furthermore,			
25	pursuant to City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 23, Section 23-6 - Award of Contract, the City			
26	Manager shall have the authority to recommend to the City Commission award of contracts; and			
27				
28	WHEREAS, the City owns and operates a water treatment plant that treats water from the			
29	Broward County Regional Wellfield Supply ("BCRWS") via the membrane softening; and			
30				
31	WHEREAS, the City also utilizes water from the City owned Biscayne Aquifer water supply			
32	Production Well No. 7 and No. 8, and this water is treated in lime softening treatment facilities			
33	and			
34				
35	WHEREAS, the City currently produces approximately six million gallons per day (mgd)			
36	of finished water, on an annual average basis, with each treatment process contributing about			
37	fifty (50) percent of the finished water; and			
38				

39	WHEREAS, the finished water from both supply wells are permitted by the South Florida		
40	Water Management District (SFWMD) Water Use Permit (WUP) No. 06-00138-W that was issued		
41	on December 16, 2013; and		
42			
43	WHEREAS, in 2013, the City authorized Hazen and Sawyer to evaluate the existing High		
44	Service Pumps (HSP), and the goals of HSP evaluation were to maximize utilization of existing		
45	HSP infrastructure, meet the projected year 2025 capacity and pressure requirements (consisting		
46	with existing infrastructure) and estimate and maximize HSP energy efficiency over existing		
47	HSP's; and		
48			
49	WHEREAS, on September 21, 2016, the City released RFP #2015-2016-25, CCNA		
50	Design High Service Pumps and Transfer Pumps at the water treatment plant; and		
51			
52	WHEREAS, on October 3, 2016, a mandatory pre-proposal meeting took place, and six		
53	(6) prospective bidders and five (5) staff members attended the meeting; and		
54			
55	WHEREAS, on October 25, 2016, the deadline for receipt of responses from proposers,		
56	and two (2) of the six (6) prospective proposers submitted proposals for the project; and		
57			
58	WHEREAS, on October 28, 2016, the Evaluation Committee met to review the two (2)		
59	proposers to determine the minimum qualification requirements for the RFP. A final evaluation		
60	meeting was held on November 21, 2016, and the City Administration is recommending the award		
61	of RFP #2015-2016-025 to Hazen and Sawyer is the best suited for this award due to its proven		
62	track record and historical involvement with the City's Water Treatment Plant; and		
63			
64	WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends that the City Commission award RFP		
65	FY #2015-2016-025, CCNA Design High Services Pumps and Transfer Pumps at the wate		
66	treatment plant to Hazen and Sawyer. The City Administration request authorization to negotiate		
67	with the succeeding ranked firm should negotiations with Hazen and Sawyer be unsuccessful		
68	and		
69			
70	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City		
71	Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.

83	Manager and City Attorney to negotiate with the succeeding ranked firm should negotiations with		
84	Hazen and Sawyer not be successful.
