Staff Summary:

Background:

The City Commission appoints Officers, Directors, Voting Delegates, and/or Alternates to represent the City of Hallandale Beach on the Broward League of Cities, Florida League of Cities, and National League of Cities Board of Directors. On April 6, 2016 the City Commission designated the following voting members for the ensuing year to represent the City:

Broward League of Cities

Director – Commissioner Keith London 1st Alternate – Commissioner Michele Lazarow 2nd Alternate – Commissioner Anthony Sanders

Florida League of Cities

Voting Delegate – Vice Mayor William "Bill" Julian 1st Alternate – Commissioner Anthony Sanders

National League of Cities

Voting Delegate – Vice Mayor William "Bill" Julian 1st Alternate – Mayor Joy F. Cooper

As a result of the November 8, 2016 General Election, the City Commission will need to consider the voting delegates for both the Florida League of Cities and National League of Cites as Vice Mayor William Julian is no longer in office.

Any appointments made by the Commission through this Resolution will take effect immediately for one year.

Please find below the dates for upcoming league conferences:

- National League of Cities Congressional City Conference to be held on March 11-15, 2017.
- National League of Cities City Summit to be held on November 15-18, 2017.
- Florida League of Cities Conference to be held on August 17-19, 2017.

Staff recommdends the City Commission consider the appointments of Officers, Directors, Voting Delegates, and/or Alternates to represent the City of Hallandale Beach on the Broward League of Cities, Florida League of Cities, and National League of Cities Board of Directors.

Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to the Broward League of Cities' By-Laws, each City shall appoint a Director, Alternate, and Second Alternate to attend and vote at any Board of Director or General Membership Meeting held where he/she represents his/her City.

Pursuant to the Florida League of Cities' By-Laws, each municipality shall appoint a Voting Delegate and an Alternate to attend and vote at the Annual Business Session.

Pursuant to the National League of Cities' By-Laws, each municipality shall appoint a Voting Delegate and up to two Alternates (if desired) to attend and vote at the Annual Business Meeting.

Pursuant to Article V, Section 5.01 of the City of Hallandale Beach Charter, a Resolution adopted by the Commission is an expression of the Commission on a provision for the disposition of a particular item of the administrative business of the governing body

Fiscal Impact:

Proposed Action:

The City Commission consider the attached Resolution appointing Commission Members as City Representatives to the Broward, Florida, and National League of Cities for one year.
