Transportation 39 is provided to the Center for students that attend Gulfstream Academy of Hallandale Beach K-8; 40 and

41	WHERAS, in order to meet the grant application deadline, the City submitted a grant
42	application on December 12, 2016, which was the deadline for submission; and
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44	WHEREAS, each grant application will be reviewed to determine eligibility. From there,
45	the Children's Services Council of Broward County evaluates each eligible application according

WHEREAS, if awarded the initial term of service for contracts awarded under the application for funding August 1, 2017, through September 30, 2018; and

to Florida Administrative Code and assigns a final score. Based on the scores, CSC prepares

and submits a recommended priority list for funding consideration. If awarded, projects will be

awarded as soon as the summer of 2017 and no later than the fall of 2017; and

WHEREAS, contract awards may be eligible for three (3) renewal periods, contingent upon but not limited to availability of funding, history of performance outcome achievement, past programmatic performance, agency viability, and successful negotiation of programmatic and budgetary issues; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends that the Mayor and City Commission ratify the submission of grant application to the Children's Services Council of Broward County submitted on December 12, 2016, to augment the existing After School Tutorial Enrichment Program located at the Austin Hepburn Center; authorize a City match of grant funds in the amount not to exceed fourteen thousand two hundred ninety three dollars and seventy six cent (\$14, 293.76); and authorize the City Manager to execute grant agreement and all related documents.
